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1. Project Background

Historically, West Bengal has played an important role for the development of the textile and apparel industry and till date it is a major manufacturer of hosiery products, garments and technical textiles. In 2019 - 20 this state has exported textiles and apparel worth ~USD 1 Bn.

West Bengal has the right combination of the factors required for the growth of the sector. Some of the key points have been highlighted below:

- 1. **Raw material availability:** West Bengal is the largest supplier of raw jute, third largest supplier of Mulberry silk and a major supplier of Purified Terepthalic Acid (PTA) which is the raw material for manufacturing of polyester fiber
- 2. **Availability of skilled manpower:** It grooms ~700 Graduates and Postgraduates for this industry every year. The educational institutes of West Bengal groom Graduates and Postgraduates in other streams (mechanical, electrical, electronics, civil engineers, industrial engineering, business management, IT etc.) which supports the growth of the sector. The TVET institutions and training centers provide skilled manpower for the shop-floor level.
- 3. **Market access:** The West Bengal government has targeted to double its textile industry in the state to INR 70,000 Crores¹ by 2024-26. This state is also the gateway to Bangladesh which imported textiles worth USD 8.82 Bn in 2020²
- 4. **Power and Water:** The State is self-sufficient with respect to power and water. It is now in a position to export power to other states after meeting its internal demand fully. It has drawn up ambitious plans for installing 100 MW Grid Connected Ground Mounted Solar PV Power Plant and Grid Connected Roof top Solar PV Power Plants.³
- 5. **Industrial Infrastructure:** A number of textile parks and apparel parks are functional / under implementation. Paridhan Garment Park (Ph 1 & Ph 2) and Regent Garment & Apparel Hub (Ph 1) are already operational. Other major parks include EIGMEF Apparel Park, Kona Integrated Garment Park, West Bengal Hosiery Park, Integrated Textile Park. Government has also planned to come up with more textile parks / clusters including apparel hubs in Nungi and Metiabruz.
- 6. Logistics and transportation: 16 National Highways are connecting the State with rest of the India and two upcoming Asian highways will connect the State with Nepal, Bhutan and Bangladesh. Upcoming Amritsar Kolkata Industrial Corridor is expected to boost industrial linkages of West Bengal with 20 cities across seven states in India. Two large container and bulk handling river ports exist at Kolkata and Haldia. One deep seaport is coming up at Tajpur. The State has two international airports at Kolkata and Bagdogra. Apart from this the domestic airport in Durgapur caters to major metros in India. The state also has planned to operationalize Coochbehar, Balurghat and Malda airports in near future.
- 7. **Policy Support:** Government of West Bengal has taken major policy reforms for the Ease of Doing Business (EoDB) which includes automation of the approval processes, digitization of the processes, increasing the tenure of validity of approvals, simplification of the processes, single window clearance system, 'No Bandh' regime, time bound service delivery etc. The state shall also support Water and

Electricity supply, skill development initiatives, ETP development etc. The industry can also benefit under PLI scheme as per GoI guidelines.

Government of West Bengal has identified following areas as strategic thrust areas for attracting new investment in textile and apparel sector in next three to five years.

- 1. Scaling up readymade garment sector
- 2. Diversifying into technical textiles
- 3. Development of complete value chain for man-made fiber-based textiles and apparel
- 4. Strengthening and upgrading weaving, knitting and hosiery industry
- 5. Developing the support ecosystem textile auxiliaries and machinery
- 6. Setting up of a designing and technology facilitation center
- 7. Promotion of cleaner production system

It is important to mention here that at present the apparel manufacturers of West Bengal source majority of their woven fabric from other States such as Maharashtra, Gujarat, and Tamil Nadu. So, the upcoming textile manufacturing units will have a ready market available to them.

With this background Government of West Bengal has planned to develop textile and apparel manufacturing units (spinning, weaving, knitting, hosiery, and garmenting) in following four locations and any other location (privately owned) within West Bengal if it meets the minimum eligibility criteria mentioned in this document.

- 1) Ashoknagar, District North 24 Parganas
- 2) Banipur, District North 24 Parganas
- 3) Kalyani, District Nadia
- 4) Raigunj, District North Dinajpur.

All the above four locations are well connected by road, rail, air, and sea. Details of the connectivity of the above four locations have been provided in the Annexure I.

The private players, who will be selected for specific location, shall be responsible for design, construction, finance, operation, and maintenance of proposed manufacturing units. If the private players are interested to set up their textile and apparel manufacturing unit within any of the following four textile parks, they have to apply for plots of land at advertised price. The price discovery mechanism for the plots within the following four textile parks will be decided at the RFP stage.

- 1) Ashoknagar, District North 24 Parganas
- 2) Banipur, District North 24 Parganas
- 3) Kalyani, District Nadia
- 4) Raiguni, District North Dinajpur.

The 4 locations may also have some existing structures, the utilisation & allocation of these will be decided during RFP stage.

2. Fiscal and non-fiscal support of Government of West Bengal

Following fiscal benefits will be provided by Government of West Bengal to **Spinning, Knitting, Hosiery and Garmenting** MSME units under 'Banglashree' scheme. However, the following subsidies have additional clauses and maximum limits. Please refer the details of the scheme provided in https://wbmsmet.gov.in

Following **non-fiscal benefits** will be provided by Government of West Bengal to all **Spinning, knitting, hosiery and Garmenting** units which will take up land within the aforementioned four textile parks:

- a) Developed land with basic common infrastructure facilities like boundary wall, internal road network etc.
- b) Common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) to ensure effluent treatment according to pollution abatement norms
- c) 24X7 uninterrupted water and electricity supply to the unit
- d) Skill Training under 'Utkarsh Bangla' Scheme
- e) Warehousing facilities on rent basis within the textile parks and apparel parks developed by GoWB
- f) Easy access to chemical / auxiliary suppliers, spare parts suppliers and other service providers as spaces will be provided to those companies within the textile parks on meeting certain conditions
- g) Facilitation service for availing benefits of the schemes / programs of Government of India and GoWB
- h) Facilitation service for all applicable permits / clearances / statutory approvals under Single Window Services portal of Silpa Sathi.

For interested **Powerloom** (preferably including processing facilities) MSME units the above-mentioned fiscal incentives will be applicable with the only change in capital incentive as follows:

In addition to the above-mentioned **non-fiscal benefits**, following additional benefits will be provided to all types of Powerloom units

a) Government of West Bengal has been providing school uniforms to all students up to Class VIII which require procurement of woven fabric (approx. 6 Crores Mtrs.). Currently, majority of this is being procured from outside of the state. The state government has envisioned to reduce this external dependency and develop fabric production capacity within the state. In line with the same, GoWB has planned to purchase minimum 50% of the required uniform fabrics (and other fabrics as decided at a later stage) for at least 3 years from the units which will be set up under this Expression of Interest and further RFP/NIT/RFQ. Later uniform fabrics for other categories (e.g., hospitals, hospitality sectors etc.) may also be added in this category thereby increasing the procurement proportionately. A price discovery mechanism will be finalized by GoWB at a later stage through a suitable transparent pricing / market pricing comparison mechanism.

Note: All other schemes / programs offered by Government of India can also be dovetailed with the abovementioned benefits.

3. Eligibility criteria

- 3.1. Minimum eligibility criteria: Manufacturers shall have to meet the minimum eligibility criteria in respect of all of the following:
 - a. The Manufacturers shall be in the business of textile and apparel manufacturing in India for at least last 3 (three) financial years (2018 19, 2019 20 and 2020 21)
 - b. The Manufacturers must have Positive Net Worth in all the last 3 (three) financial years (2018 19, 2019 20 and 2020 21)
 - c. The Manufacturers have a minimum average Annual Turnover of INR 25.00 crores (Rupees Twenty-Five Crores) in the financial years 2018 19, 2019 20 and 2020 21
 - d. The Manufacturers must have ISO9001 certification.
 - e. The Manufacturer has not been barred by any ministry / department / organization of Government of India (GoI) or GoWB for participation in any project and the same subsists on the day of submission of the EOI.
 - f. If the applicant is interested to set up the manufacturing unit on his own land, the land area should be minimum 5 acres. The incentives, qualification criteria and documentation of such applicants shall be as per State Approved Industrial Park (SAIP) scheme for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises.

4. Submission of EOI

The applicant has to furnish the following documents:

- 4.4 Copy of PAN Card
- 4.5 Copy of GST Registration Certificate
- 4.6 Copy of Trade License
- 4.7 Statement of Annual Turnover & Net Worth during last 3 (three) financial years certified by a qualified Chartered Accountant as per Form–3
- 4.8 Income Tax certificate for last 3 (three) financial years ending 31st March,2021
- 4.9 Valid ISO Certificate
- 4.10 Other supporting documents in support of the Eligibility Criteria (Section 3. Eligibility Criteria Page-9)
- 4.11 Planned investment in terms of value (Rs. Crores) and volume (installed capacity in Mtrs / 8 hours of production considering 100% utilization with no down time)
- 4.12 The applicant Manufacturers may also submit their suggestions and views, which are considered important by them in a separate sheet
- 4.4 At this EOI stage, no financial bid is required to be submitted.

5. Steps subsequent to submission of EOI

- 5.1 MSME&T Deptt. may get in touch with the applicant Manufacturers who have submitted EOI to get further clarifications, if required.
- 5.2 A meeting may be conducted with interested applicants post the submission of EOI to discuss their views and suggestions submitted by them as part of their respective EOIs.
- 5.3 After assessing the responses from the applicant Manufacturers, MSME&T Deptt. may initiate the bidding process if required (through the issuance of Request for Qualification/ Proposal/ Biddocument and Notice Inviting Tender) for selecting Manufacturer(s) for setting up plants in the earmarked plot of land.
- 5.4 It is made clear that the bidding process if undertaken would not be confined only to the applicant Manufacturers who have submitted Expression of Interest. The bidding would be an independent process consisting of the Request for Qualification/ Proposal/ Bid document and Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) for submission of bids in the Tender process to be undertaken by MSME&T Deptt.

6. Proposed Bidding Process

- 6.1 MSME&T Department has envisaged adopting a single-stage bidding process for the selection of Manufacturer(s). The bidding process will be undertaken via online mode only.
- 6.2 Technical and financial criteria would be defined in Request for Qualification/ Proposal/ Bid-document and Notice Inviting Tender which will be issued later.
- 6.3 All interested Manufacturers would be required to submit their Technical Bid and Financial Bid in response to the Request for Qualification /Proposal /Bid document and Notice Inviting Tender which will be issued later.

7. Information and Instructions to Applicants

- 7.1 All information called for in the enclosed forms should be furnished against the relevant columns in the Forms. If for any reason, information is furnished on a separate sheet, this fact should be mentioned against the relevant column. Even if no information is to be provided in a column, a "nil" or "no such case" entry should be made in that column. If any particular/ query is not applicable in case of the applicant, it should be stated as "not applicable". The applicants are cautioned that not giving complete information called for in the application forms or not giving it in clear terms or making any change in the prescribed forms or deliberately suppressing the information shall result in the applicant being summarily disqualified.
- 7.2 The application should be type-written. The applicant should sign each page of the application.
- 7.3 The applicant may furnish any additional information, which is deemed necessary to establish capability. Superfluous information need not be furnished, and no information shall be entertained after submission of EOI document unless specifically called for.
- 7.4 Any information furnished by the applicant found to be incorrect either immediately or at a later date, would render him liable to be debarred from participating in subsequent stages of this bidding process
- 7.5 The EOI in prescribed form duly completed and signed should be submitted on the website https://wbmsmet.gov.in/home/tender.
- 7.6 The particulars of the Manufacturer given in the Information Memorandum are indicative only, subject to change and may be considered only as advance information to assist the applicant.






| Distance of Ashoknagar & Banipur Textile Park from Major transit points | | |







